Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as determined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The following prescriptions of US Sailing will apply and will be stated in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 Equipment is required to conform to the rules of the IM17CA & MCSA.

2. Advertising

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the M17 & MC classes.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form by October 20th or at the time of registration.

4. Fees

- 4.1 The required fees are as follows. \$100.00 Checks (Catawba Yacht Club).
- 4.2 Entry fee includes: Friday Appetizers, Continental Breakfasts, Saturday Dinner and Sunday Lunch, Launching and Racing.
- 4.3 Additional Lunches can be purchased for \$10.00 per person.
- 4.4 Additional Dinners can be purchased for \$20.00 per person.

5. Schedule

- 5.1 Registration: Friday, October 20th, 2006 from 4-7 PM and October 21st from 8-9 AM.
- 5.2 Dates of Racing: Saturday, October 21st and Sunday, October 22nd, 2006.
- 5.3 The scheduled time of Warning Signal for the First Race is 10:30AM.
- 5.4 No Warning Signal will be made after 1:30 PM Sunday October 22nd.

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

7. Venue - Catawba Yacht Club is located at 19809 W. Youngblood Rd
Charlotte, NC 28278

7.1 The racing area is On Lake Wylie, Just West of the CYC Cove.

8. Courses

8.1 The Courses to be sailed will be Windward-Leeward with the discretion to finish downwind.

9. Scoring

9.1 The Low Point Scoring System described in appendix "A" of the RRS will apply, except a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. No more than six races will be held.

10. Radio Communications

10.1 A boat will neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to cellular telephones.

11. Prizes

11.1 Prizes will be awarded as follows: Top 3 in each Class.

12. Disclaimer of Liability

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race

12.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

12.3 Competitors will be required to wear Coast Guard Approved life jackets while on the water.
