Notice of Race

1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as determined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

The following prescriptions of US Sailing will apply and will be stated in full in the sailing instructions.

Equipment is required to conform to the rules of the IM17CA.

2. Advertising

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. Eligibility and Entry

The Regatta is open to all boats of the M17 class. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form by April 20th or at the time of registration.

4. Fees

The required fees are as follows. \$150.00 Checks (made out to Lake Geneva Yacht Club) or credit cards are acceptable forms of payment.

Entry fee includes: Friday Appetizers, Continental Breakfasts, Saturday Lunch and Dinner and Sunday Lunch, Launching, Coaching and Racing.

Additional Lunches can be purchased for \$10.00 per person.

Additional Dinners can be purchased for \$20.00 per person.

5. Schedule

Registration: Friday, May 09th, 2007 from 4-7 PM and May 10th from 8-9 AM.

Dates of Racing: Saturday May 10th and Sunday May 11th, 2006.

The scheduled time of Warning Signal for the First Race is 10:30AM.

No Warning Signal will be made after 1:30 PM Sunday May 14th.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

7. Coaching

Coaching will be allowed before, during and after racing. Racing video debriefing will be after racing.

8. Venue

The Lake Geneva Yacht Club is located at W4780 South Lake Shore Drive, Fontana, WI. 53125 The racing area is the West end of Lake Geneva.

9. Courses

The Courses to be sailed will be Windward-Leeward with the discretion to finish downwind.

10. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System described in appendix "A" of the RRS will apply, except a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. No more than six races will be held.

11. Radio Communications

A boat will neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to cellular telephones.

12. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded as follows: Top 5.

13. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

Due to the cold water temperature competitors will be required to wear Coast Guard Approved life jackets while on the water.
